RULES FOR BOOK BANK SCHEME

The cadets are advised to adhere to the following rules for Book Bank Scheme: -

1. The Books Bank Scheme implementation has commenced from the current Academic Session 2020-21 & will be applicable to cadets of all semester of B. Tech (ME).
2. As per the Book Bank Scheme, text books will be issued to cadets for the period of one semester as per School Board's recommendation / Campus recommendation (few books).
3. The Textbooks issued under Book Bank scheme are to be returned after completion of end semester examination within the date stipulated by Library.
4. Cadets have to return the issued textbooks by the end of semester exam. The last date of return will be put on the Library Notice Board.
5. Cadets have to check the books before borrowing from Book Bank. Any claim later regarding loss of pages / damage will not be entertained.
6. In case of failure in returning of books in Book Bank, a fine of Rs 5/- per Day/Book shall be imposed and no further issue of books shall take place till all the old books are returned and fine paid.
7. The textbooks shall be returned in good condition without any overwriting, marking and tearing of pages etc. If Books are lost or damaged by cadets (except fair wear & tear), books shall be replaced with current edition of the book. In case book is not available, then cadet will have to pay double the cost of book along with fine of Rs 5/day/book as per Library Policy.
8. The book Bank scheme is intended to be a major environmental initiative of reducing paper consumption. All are expected to do their bit for healthy environment.
